


Welcome to the Showtimes Entry tool

What is the showtimes entry tool?


If you don't use a point of sale system, or if you use a POS that we aren't integrated with, then the showtimes entry tool allows you to enter your programming manually. With this, we'll be able to build you a website, or send your showtimes to Google and other major search platforms.








Click on the settings wheel to set your opening and closing time, and usual pre-show duration. It will resize the grid accordingly.




Let's start adding movies to your grid. Either:


- Click on the **Movies** button in the top right corner and drag and drop movies you're playing at the right time.
- Click anywhere in the grid and type the title of the movie you want to add.



When adding a movie manually, click on to enter the name of the movie.

The length of the movie box is automatically calculated based on your typical pre-show duration and the length of the movie.






When editing a movie, you will see the full details of the movie: auditorium #, date and showtime, its title, ratings, and duration.


You can then add attributes (ex: 3D, Imax, etc.) as well as a booking URL.

Once you've added a movie, these actions will enable you to create your programming even faster:

- Click on the stamp icon 🚣 , then click anywhere to paste a copy
- Click on the Duplicate icon ⋤ to duplicate this programming at scale!



If your programming for Auditorium 2 on Monday is going to look a lot like your programming on another day, then simply click \bigcirc and select "Duplicate on selected dates" to recreate the same programming for another date.
